Overview

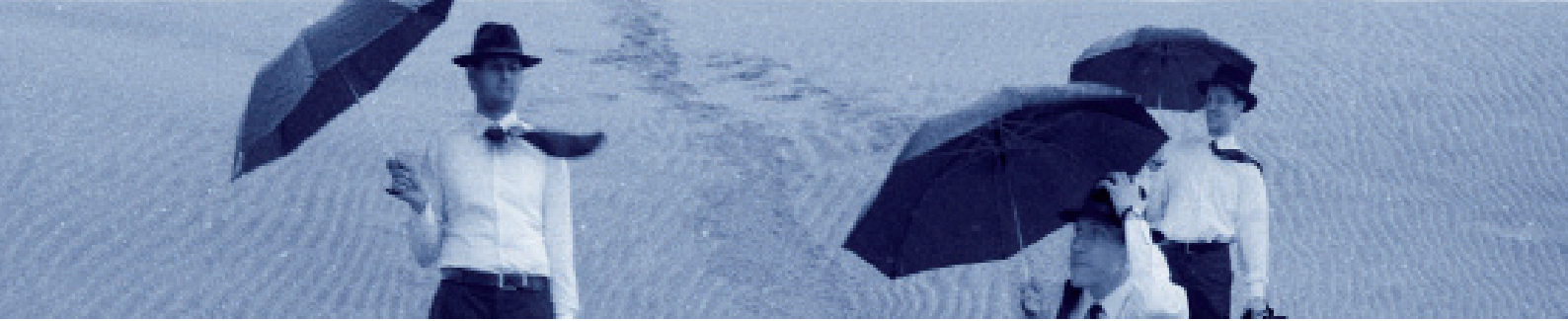
The Renewable Energy Directive and its sister Fuel Quality Directive are placing increasing requirements on the suppliers of biomass, biofuels and bioliquids into the European Market both to demonstrate the sustainable credentials of the products placed on the European Market and establish clearly defined and demonstrable chains-of-custody.

This course is designed to provide manufacturers, suppliers and traders in the biofuels sector with the necessary tools, techniques and systems to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of the RED and additional client specific contractual requirements. It extends the one day Renewable Energy Directive for Suppliers into the European Marketplace in order to provide practical advice on compliance and reporting.
