# Understanding and Implementing the UK Carbon Reduction Commitment (CRC)

## Overview

This course is designed to provide understanding of the CRC Scheme's rules and requirements as well as the tools needed to produce accurate emission reports.

From April 1st 2010 the UK CRC scheme came into effect requiring all companies who use 6000 MWh electricity or over to monitor their total energy usage and report their emissions annually, with the first report required by March next year.

However, many companies are unsure of the qualification criteria and how to implement the systems required for reporting their carbon emissions for verification.

Our course is designed to provide understanding of the CRC Scheme's rules and requirements as well as the data management methods and systems required to produce accurate emission reports. The course will also offer insight into the auditing requirements for the CRC scheme along with guidance in preparing for verification.
